

CODE OF CONDUCT

International Congress Amphorae et Dolia

All individuals attending the conference must agree to the following code of conduct. The organizing team will enforce this code throughout the event.

The Catalan Institute of Classical Archaeology (ICAC) aims to ensure a **harassment-free conference** experience for everyone, regardless of gender, gender identity and expression, age, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, ethnicity, religion (or lack thereof), or technology choices. We do not tolerate harassment of conference participants in any form. Individuals violating these rules may be sanctioned or expelled from the conference without a refund at the discretion of the conference organizers.

Examples of unacceptable behaviours include:

- Offensive or discriminatory comments, both verbal and written.
- Intimidation, harassment, threats, or stalking.
- Photography or recording of individuals without their explicit consent.
- Inappropriate physical contact and unwelcome sexual attention.

If you are being harassed, notice that someone else is being harassed, or have any other concerns, please **contact a member of the conference staff immediately**. The organizing team will assist in contacting ICAC referrals or local police and judicial authorities if necessary.
